One option suggested was to have the initial set-up cost (\$3500) go through the EMS Council to cover all of Spokane County agencies. Each agency would then pay Handtevy directly a percentage of the cost going forward based on their agency's number of EMS calls. Handtevy can bill each agency separately.
