## **NEW BUSINESS:**

COVID-19 Discussion/Update (Adam Richards & Mike Lopez)

The question was asked whether EMS agencies can access Spokane County Federal CARES Act monies to help replace COVID-necessary PPE, HEPA filters, cleaning supplies, etc. Chief Brian Schaeffer suggested that the EMS Council request funds for the agencies as a group. Dr. Nania, with Mike Lopez's assistance, will draft a letter to the three Spokane County Commissioners requesting CARES Act funds, which will then be distributed to Spokane County agencies for purchase of PPE and other COVID-related items. Agencies will be asked to send in a list of the COVID-related supplies they will need for 2021 and the cost they expect to incur.

Adam Richards and Carolyn Cartwright provided some regional COVID updates.

Tom Chavez made the Council aware that since September Immaculate Heart Retreat House off the Palouse Highway on the South Hill has 50 beds for COVID-related care. They've had up to 5 patients at a time who are COVID positive. Tom said the retreat house staff provide a daily update to SCFD8 on bed availability. The retreat house staff do not provide any nursing care but provide a place for people who are waiting to find out if they are positive for COVID and don't have a place to go or can't quarantine themselves at home.
